Congratulations to the winners of our 29th Annual Write and Illustrate Your Own Book Contest. At the Award Ceremony held on March 19, the following children won awards:

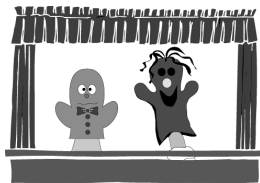
