- Trustee Huggins mentioned that there was an approximate start date with the vestibules of this week, can we get an update?
- Dr. Rianna mentioned that due to so many other districts put in this same type of construction projects there's a backup we are estimated the second week in September for that project to kick off. We did indicate to all buildings that none of the construction will happen during the school day. They will work nights and weekends to get it done.
- Trustee Juarez stated that if possible to make sure that all the components to the project be there prior to construction starting so that we're not waiting 4-5 weeks for items once the project has started.

Public Participation

The following topics were presented during the public participation section on any items.

- ➤ I'm the grandmother of a 6th grader at the middle school on the McGrath team which is upstairs and there's no air conditioning in any of those classrooms. It really took a toll on her. When chrome books first were introduced in the district I believe trustee Juarez brought up the issue of paying for insurance and he was questioning what a parent would do if they couldn't afford it? My daughter can't afford the insurance. I told her that I remember from a board meeting that if you couldn't afford it you wouldn't have to pay for it. My daughter questioned it when she went to get hers at the middle school and was told that she had to pay for the insurance. I feel that it's wrong and there are a lot of families in Glen Cove that can't afford the \$30 insurance for the chrome books. She was told flat out that if she didn't sign the paper promising to pay insurance that she wasn't going to get a chrome book. It was in today newspaper that France mandated that student will not have any mobile devices allowed in the classrooms unless they're chrome and iPads making it less distracting. For the student social, emotional well-being. Our children are identifying themselves with how they are perceived on social media. Some children only post positive things making other children feel that one's life is wonderful and mine if horrible. What are you doing in Glen Cove? Is there something in our curriculum, at any level, to incorporate something in health education where kids actually have a course or a class that talks about technology and how it affects self-esteem and what to do to keep it all together. I know the state came out with something on social emotional learning.
- I know of about 180 children around the age of ten that had no electronics and relied on radios and anything you could play and they survived the whole summer.

If they can do it anyone can. I have a cell phone and I don't use it and I see people that can't take it off there ear. There's no reason why the school should have to put up with that. It's so much more prevalent now that they have to respond immediately. Children have to learn how to deal with this and that it's not going to hurt them. You tell them, you really think your friends are going to tell you what type of day they really had? No, and you don't do it either.
