Meeting Date: April 7, 2014 - VETERANS EXEMPTION - Middle School**

ACTION	Board Action								
<p><b>WHEREAS</b>, New York Real Property Tax Law section 458-a was amended to provide eligible veterans with a real property tax exemption from school taxes so long as the School District in which the real property is located, after public hearing, adopts a resolution authorizing the exemption;</p> <p><b>NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED</b>, that the Board of Education of the Glen Cove City School District hereby authorizes the application of the Veteran Tax Exemption as contained in New York Real Property Tax Law section 458-a, as amended, and such exemption shall be applicable to school taxes; and</p> <p><b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b>, that the Board of Education hereby adopts the following alternative maximum exemption allowable in Real Property Tax Law, section 458-a(2) (a), (b) and (c) as follows:</p> <table border="1" data-bbox="334 627 805 800"> <thead> <tr> <th></th> <th align="center"><b>Basic Maximum</b></th> </tr> </thead> <tbody> <tr> <td>Wartime</td> <td align="center">\$12,000</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Combat Zone</td> <td align="center">\$ 8,000</td> </tr> <tr> <td>Disability</td> <td align="center">\$40,000</td> </tr> </tbody> </table>		<b>Basic Maximum</b>	Wartime	\$12,000	Combat Zone	\$ 8,000	Disability	\$40,000
