Audit Committee Charter

Superintendent's Report:

Dr. Aronstein reported that there has been significant progress on the work being preformed under the Performance Contract. He asked **Mr. Wurtz** to provide the following brief summary of the work that has taken place, thus far.

- Approximately 35% of the roof, being replaced at the Middle School, has been completed.
- The fire, that destroyed materials belonging to the contractor, did not delay any of the work
- Asbestos abatement work being conducted at the Middle and High schools is in progress
- Four boilers at Deasy School are being cut up in pieces for removal
- The installation of new lighting is nearly completed within the district
- A request for quotes for the modulars to house fifth-grade classes at both Landing and Connolly schools were sent out for re-bids. The new bids will be opened on August 1st.
- **Dr. Aronstein** reported that the State has provided funds for school districts across the State an *Excel Grant*. This grant program will provide the Glen Cove School District with almost one million dollars for capital improvement projects.
