PRESENTATIONS:

1. The High School Select Chorale under the direction of **Mr. Norris** and **Mr. Reardon's** Middle School Jazz Band performed Holiday music for the audience.
2. **Dr. Aronstein** reported on a proposal from the Tripod Project, outlining the costs involved in administering student and teacher questionnaires in grades 6-12 and the development of reports. These reports will analyze data and draw implications. It is anticipated that there will be follow up work by Dr. Ferguson at the March 2007 Superintendent's Conference Day. Dr. Aronstein addressed questions from the Board members and members of the audience regarding the presentation.
3. **Mr. Schenker** and **Dr. Camhi** presented an overview of the International Baccalaureate (IB) program. The IB program is generally considered the most outstanding academic offerings throughout the world that prepares students for the rigors of demanding college education. This informative presentation is a first step in adopting an IB program at the 11th and 12th grades. Eventually this program will have a Middle school and Elementary school component over the next five years. Mr. Schenker and Dr. Camhi addressed questions from Board members and members of the audience regarding the presentation.

REPORTS:

- **Mr. Wurtz** reported on the re-registration of all students throughout our district. He described the process and the results of this extensive effort.
