**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that, commencing with the Budget Vote to be held on May 17, 2016 and all school district votes and elections thereafter, the Glen Cove City School District, the Board of Education shall designate two polling places for all future school district budget votes and elections.

### **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT:**

The designated election districts for each attendance zone shall be as follows:

# Robert M. Finley Middle School

Election districts A, B, G shall be re-designated as Election District A without any change in the geographical boundaries of the election districts and the new polling location will be the Glen Cove High School.

# **Landing Elementary School**

Election district E shall be re-designated as Election District B without any change in the geographical boundaries of the election district and the new polling location will be the Glen Cove High School.

# Glen Cove Boys & Girls Club

Election district D shall be re-designated as Election District C without any change in the geographical boundaries of the election district and the new polling location will be the Glen Cove High School.

# Margaret A. Connolly School

Election district F shall be re-designated as Election District D and shall remain at Margaret A. Connolly School.
