Finley Middle School

- 3 Full-Time (1 bilingual)
- Avg. Caseload per Counselor: 243 students; inclusive of 12 students who attend an out-of-district placement

Glen Cove High School

- 5 Full-Time (2 bilingual)

Average Caseload per Counselor: 224 students; inclusive of 42 who attend an attend out-of-district placement

ENL Counselor: 203 caseload

*188 Avg. caseload size among neighboring ten districts

Changes to School Counseling Regulations



- School counseling regulations have not been reviewed or revised in New York State since the 1970's. They have now been reformulated to integrate current thinking and practice in the field.
- Amended to “Guidance programs and comprehensive developmental school counseling programs”
- Change in cert./training of aspiring counselors

Significant Changes



Each school district shall develop comprehensive developmental school counseling/guidance plans under the direction of certified school counselors

Each school district plan: **Completed**

All students K -12 must have **access** to and programs designed by a certified school counselor (CSC): **Completed**

Create a Advisory Council for program review: **Completed**

2019-2020 Updates



Additional Counselor: 1 ENL Counselor

- Assist with influx of new Spanish speaking families, help support transition between grades, develop a strong connection between student/families, and provide hands on guidance.

Introduced student online course requests

- Students were able to select course requests independently along with parents.
