IV. Superintendent Report

A. Updates

1. Teacher Recognition

Dr. Maria Rianna turned this section of the meeting over to Dr. Michael Israel who recognized Antoinet Hatzopoulos from Gribbin school who was selected last year for the Long Island Council for Social Studies Margaret Simon Award for Excellence in Elementary Social Studies Education and this year for the New York State Council for the Social Studies Outstanding Social Studies Classroom Teacher Award and was presented with this award virtually at the Annual New York State Council Conference for Social Studies on March 12th. A thank you presentation was viewed from Ms. Hatzopoulos. The Board of Education congratulated her.

2. COVID-19 Update

Dr. Maria Rianna mentioned that Reimaged New York Commission announced the launch of ConnectEd NY. This is an emergency fund providing two districts free internet access through June 2022. The funding will be provided from different foundations and our district is eligible to apply. We're moving forward with submitting our application that has a deadline of April 14th. Dr. Rianna went over the wording changes from the CDC (Center for Disease Control) that came out on March 19th and went over what some of that means.
