Regents exam results for Glen Cove High School for the years 2006-2007 through 2011-2012.
The 2012 ELA and Math scores for the students in grades 3 through 8 who achieved a high level 2 and who were within one point, two points, or three points of a level 3 achievement percent at or above the Nassau County average.
The possible reasons for the district's scores being lower than the Nassau County averages and the possible actions that could be taken to bring about higher achievement levels (the memo from Dr. Israel dated September 19, 2012 is available in the office of the district clerk).
